NOTES: Channels coincide with Midas M32/Behringer X32 banks; greylines are channels not used

There should be 7 monitor mixes:

Mix #2 & 5 = IEM (access to mixer router and IP address required) - Band travels with their own IEM's (or use yours)

Mix #1, 3 & 4 = front line wedges

Mix #6 = Drummer IEM or wedge

Mix #7 = Drummer Sub

As a reference, all vocals are to be included in Mix #1-5

A good starting point for IEM mix is:

Vocals at '-10db; 0db for person wearing IEM

Instruments at '-15db/-20db; -10db on the instrument that is wearing IEM
